All winners of Junior classes (under 21 months) are eligible to compete for Junior Champion of All Beef Breeds in their respective sex.

Interbreed sashes for Junior/Senior Champion Bull & Female, Supreme Champion Animal and Interbreed Group.

STOCK PASSES: One pass per 3 to 5 Animals or part thereof will be issued.

JUDGING

Beef cattle to commence breed judging at 9.00am on Saturday October 22nd. Calf Classic, Junior Handler and Judging will follow the completion of breed judging.

The Society reserves the right to substitute a judge when deemed necessary. Persons other than judges and stewards are not permitted in the ring unless permission is granted by the judge.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a. No restriction on number of entries per class, however should the number of entries received exceed the number that can be accommodated the Society reserves the right to reduce the number of entries in whatever manner it deems fit.
- b. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that all animals are paraded in their correct classes and age groups. Automatic disqualification of the animal from all classes will be the penalty for a breach of this rule.
- c. Exhibitors can substitute animals entered provided there is a valid reason and approval is obtained from the Supervisor no later than 7 days prior to the show. The substitute animal must be in the same class as the scratched animal.

All scratchings to be notified to the Secretary by Friday 14th October prior to the Show otherwise penalties may be imposed.
- d. Exhibitors are required to supply their own water and feed bins. Bedding supplied – no straw.
- e. Each exhibitor is required to see that each of their exhibits is securely tethered in its stall.
- f. Exhibitors are to have stalls cleaned out and waste removed to designated area by 8am each day. **At the end of the Show all waste is to be raked into aisles. All rubbish to be deposited in designated area.**
- g. Aisles to be maintained free of faecal matter at all times.
- h. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor, or held by the exhibitor under a written and recorded lease, at time of entry.
- i. All exhibits must be in good general health on arrival at showgrounds.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

1. All electrical appliances and power leads must comply with AS3760 2003.
2. All electrical appliances and power leads to have current compliance tags attached to the supply end of the lead.
3. Cables must not be laid on the ground in areas accessible to the public or vehicular traffic.
4. Appliances and power cables must not be used or laid in wet areas.
5. Leads may be supported overhead (no joins permitted).
6. Minimum clearance: Areas subject to vehicular traffic 6m, other areas 2.5m. Exhibitors should supply their own safety switch (RCD) for installation at each power outlet they use.
7. Representatives from the office of Technical Regulators and Workplace Services will be on site during the show and electrical non-compliance identified by them could result in prosecution.

TRAFFIC CONTROL & PARKING

For the duration of the Show the speed limit is 5 kph (walking pace). Parking is only permitted in designated areas. Vehicle access to the show grounds proper, will not be allowed between 9am-9pm Friday and 9am-11pm Saturday.

FIREWORKS

There will be a Fireworks Display on the Arena on Saturday 22nd at approximately 9:00pm. All livestock remaining on the grounds are to be supervised during the display.

BEEF CATTLE

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS BEEF

1. All Exhibits must be declared free of TB, Brucellosis and other notifiable diseases.
2. Enzootic Bovine Leucosis (EBL), a declaration must be signed by the exhibitor that EBL has not known to exist in cattle on the property in the previous 5 years.
3. The minimum status requirement for entry is Johne's Beef Assurance Score (J-BAS) of 6. Exhibitors must complete Question 6 on the National Cattle Health Declaration stating their score and return with entry form/s.
4. All cattle will be required to be tested for Pestivirus (including calves) and certified as non-PI (persistently infected). Exhibitors must complete question 3 on the National Cattle Health Declaration stating this testing is complete

The National Cattle Health Declaration (latest version) **must** be submitted with the entry forms otherwise the entry will not be accepted.

BEEF CATTLE CONDITIONS:

- a) **Arrival.** Cattle can be received at the Showgrounds from Wednesday.
- b) **Final beef cattle pen time is on Saturday at 8:00am**
- c) **Departure.** All beef cattle are to remain until 2.00pm on Saturday. Unless specified by the supervisor.
- d) All breeds of Beef Cattle must be registered with their various Herd Societies to be eligible for competition.
- e) All male cattle over the age of 12 months, shall be rung through the nose.
- f) Every animal must be securely tethered by an effective head stall and neck rope.
- g) All tattoos and/or freeze brands must correspond with entries or the entries will be rejected.
- h) **Age of Beef Cattle to date from 1st October, 2022.** All beef cattle 21 months and over to compete in Senior Classes.

All calves at foot to be under 9 months of age (born 1/1/2022.

9 - 13 months (1/9/2021 - 31/12/2021)

Over 13 – 17 months (1/5/2021 - 31/8/2021)

Over 17 – 21 months (1/1/2021 - 30/4/2021)

Over 21 – 25 months (1/9/2020 - 31/12/2020)

BC12. YOUNG HANDLER COMPETITION (15 to 25 years)
Entrants to be over 15 and under 25 years of age on 1st May, 2022. Exhibitor required to prepare an animal of any age prior to judging and parade animal before Judge.
Prize money, 1st \$15, 2nd \$10, 3rd \$5.

One animal per entrant i.e. Cow & calf cannot both go out as one entrant. Entrant must be willing to swap animals if requested. Animals are to be exhibited in their age groups for the breed show. First and Second place getters names forwarded to RAHS.

BC13. BEEF CATTLE JUDGING COMPETITION (Under 25 years)
Open to persons under 25 years of age on 1st May 2022.
Prize money 1st \$25, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10.
